

Wisconsin Historical Society parking

There are several parking choices within a block or two of the Society. Do note that the Memorial Union construction project may disrupt traffic and some parking options. For up-to-date information, see the UW campus [street closures and detours map](#).

On campus parking

Helen C. White Garage, entrance at 600 N. Park St.
Grainger Hall Garage, entrance at 341 N. Brooks St.

Cost of parking at either garage is \$2/hour for the first two hours and \$1/hour after that up to a \$12 daily maximum.

As of mid-September, there were no events scheduled that would affect parking in these garages. However, that could change, and parking in garages cannot be reserved in advance. Anyone needing guaranteed parking should order a visitor parking permit for one of the university's surface lots (91, 41, 34, 62, 59 or 60 – all of which are some distance from the WHS but shuttles may be available). These lots are viewable on the interactive map at www.maps.wisc.edu. Permits cost \$12/day and can be ordered online: www.transportation.wisc.edu/forms/visitorAdvance2.aspx.

Visitors with Limited Mobility: You may be dropped off and picked up in the small staff parking lot on the corner of Park and Langdon Streets.

City of Madison parking

State Street Campus Garage (entrances at 400 N. Frances St. and 400 N. Lake St.) is just off campus. The rate is \$1.25/hour with a \$5 maximum for nights and weekends. They accept Visa, MasterCard and cash. Check here to view real-time parking space availability: www.cityofmadison.com/parkingUtility/garagesLots/availability/.

Evening is defined as 6 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday through Friday, and weekend as 5 a.m. Saturday to 5 a.m. Monday. If you parked in this garage for your entire visit to Madison (Thursday evening to Saturday afternoon), the total charge would be \$30.
